Location:46336 First Avenue (a portion of)Applicant:Heritage Reformed ChurchPurposes:To amend the 2040 Official Community Plan designation for a portion of the subjectproperty from "Residential 3 - Low Rise Apartment" to "Residential 1 – Single Family Attached", and torezone a portion of the subject property, as shown on the map below, from a P1 (Civic Assembly) Zone toan R3 (Small Lot One Family Residential) Zone to facilitate a future subdivision.
