## 1. ZONING BYLAW AMENDMENT BYLAW 2021, No. 5049 (RZ001476)

**Applicant:** City of Chilliwack

**Purpose:** To amend the text of the R1-C (Urban Infill) Zone to reduce the maximum

building height for residential uses from 10m to 8.5m to limit new

residential infill development on narrow lots to two storeys.

As a result of the public health emergency and resulting restrictions on public gatherings, public attendance at City Hall for Council meetings is not permitted at this time. Until this matter is resolved and the restrictions have been lifted, Council is not conducting public hearings regarding proposed zoning bylaw amendments.
