

CAMPAIGN FINANCING, DISCLOSURE, AND ELECTION ADVERTISING

Elections BC administers campaign financing, disclosure, and election advertising rules under the Local Elections Campaign Financing Act. New campaign financing and advertising rules are in effect for the 2022 local general election. Candidates, electoral organizations, and third-party advertisers are responsible for knowing the rules. For more information visit the Elections BC website.

Candidates and third-party sponsors have expense limits that apply during the campaign period. Expense limits for the 2022 election will be announced on May 31, 2022. Candidate Expense Limits for the City of Chilliwack are available on the Elections BC website. Third-Party Expense Limits for the City of Chilliwack are also available on the Elections BC website.

All candidates are required to submit their financial disclosure documents to Elections BC for verification and publication, in compliance with the Local Elections Campaign Financing Act. Financial disclosure statements can be viewed on the Elections BC website, when available.

Elector organizations are required to register with Elections BC in order to endorse a candidate in an election, receive a campaign contribution, and incur an election expense. Please visit the Elections BC website for additional information.
