**1. CALL TO ORDER**

Acting Chair Westeringh called the meeting to order at 8:14 am.

**4. NEW BUSINESS TO ADDRESS**

Discussion and ranking of artists interest submission for 2024 street banners.

**5. INFORMATION / DISCUSSION**

Submissions of artist interest and their portfolios were received from 10 artists for the 2024 street banner call out. Electronic copies were emailed to all members of the PAAC on May 9, 2024, along with a ranking check sheet to be used for todays meeting.

1<sup>st</sup> round of voting to rank all 10 artists took place and Carol read out the top 5.

2<sup>nd</sup> round of voting to rank the top 5 artists down to the final 3 for banner submission took place. Positions 1 and 2 were determined, however there was a tie for position 3.

Discussion took place as to options and ways to break the tie. Voting between the 2 artists tied was determined to be the way to proceed.

3<sup>rd</sup> round of voting to break the tie between the 2 artists for 3<sup>rd</sup> position resulted in another tie. 4<sup>th</sup> round of voting to break the tie between the 2 artists for 3<sup>rd</sup> position determined the third position.

Carol will notify all applicants of the results and request the 3 artists who will be moving forward to submit their banner proposals. PAAC meeting to be held May 31, 2024 to vote on the successful banner and artist for the 2024 street banners.

Update was requested for the Lickman Road roundabout. This project is still in process as there has been some challenges with the previous suggestion for an antique piece of farm equipment and corn and blueberry plants.

Update was requested on the new Western Irrigation building as to the status of the public art that was supposed to be installed. Councillor Westeringh explained that the client is expected to complete the public art, but that it may take up to a year and that the City has a \$ deposit from the client that would not be returned back to them if they did not complete the approved public art piece.

Questions asked about the process to initiate a request to the PAAC for public art at other locations within the City. Carol explained the process that groups/organizations/businesses would follow if they were interested in pursuing public art.
